Structured approach

A structured approach is crucial to meet the challenges of any control center conversion or new-build. This method is called project management. It allows us to carry out tasks in a given timeframe and within a specified environment with limited resources. Projects will succeed if the magic triangle of costs, deadlines and functions can be held in equilibrium throughout all phases.

Projects are by definition individual organizational undertakings. In a 24/7 environment, they interface frequently with other organizational units and projects and have a reciprocal- impact – which may be either positive or negative. These impacts can be controlled by following a project-specific risk management plan.

The project process is standardized: To begin with, the strategy is defined and tested for feasibility. The subsequent preliminary study describes the parameters, objectives and risks of potential solutions, in some cases with indications of costs and deadlines. During the project design phase, the selected solution is mapped out and tenders are subsequently invited. The most economic solutions can be achieved if a lot of suitable providers submit offers. The final project phase (realization) comprises implementation and construction.

Projects of longer duration are divided into individual phases, and complex projects into subprojects. This gives you a guarantee that your projects remain manageable and controllable. An additional benefit of dividing into phases and subprojects is that interdisciplinary projects are made transparent for everyone involved and the expert teams can process findings faster.
